

How to Install WATT Programs

Welcome to the Winning at the Track (WATT) Demo

Install the **WATT demo** and the **WATT tutorial** quickly and easily by just following the step-by-step instructions below. If WATT is already installed, the tutorial is ready to use. Are you a computer novice? This file is for you!

Create a new folder on your C: drive (name the folder TRACK)

1. In the lower left corner of your Windows Desktop, click START, click PROGRAMS.
2. Go to ACCESSORIES.
3. Next, click COMMAND PROMPT (a black box will open on the screen).
4. Type the following on your keyboard: CD\ (then, hit the "Enter" key).
5. At the blinking C:\> prompt, type this: MD TRACK (hit "Enter").
6. At the C:\> prompt, type: CD\TRACK (hit "Enter" to go to TRACK folder).

Now appearing in the black window you will see C:\TRACK>

Download the FreeWATT demo file into your new folder

7. Right click the FREEWATT.ZIP file at the **HorseRacingUSA.com** website.
8. Click "Save Target As..."
9. When the "Save In" box appears, change the path to "Local Disc C:\"
10. Look for the yellow folder called TRACK, highlight the folder, and then click "Open". Now, the folder TRACK is noted at the top.
11. Save the FREEWATT.ZIP file into the new TRACK folder (click SAVE).
12. Open the FREEWATT.ZIP file with PKUNZIP (see the next page).

The **Tutorial** and the **FreeWATT** demo programs will run instantly by typing the keywords TUTOR or WATT after the C:\TRACK> prompt. Or...

The Tutorial can also be run using Windows in the following manner...

13. At your Windows Desktop, click START, and then click RUN.

14. In the "Open" box, run the tutorial by typing the following message:

C:\track\tutor.bat (click "OK")

Installing your new Winning at the Track (WATT) programs:

Create a TRACK folder for your new WATT programs:

- Follow steps 1 - 6 above. Name the new WATT folder TRACK.

Your TRACK folder is now ready to accept the three WATT compressed (zip) files, usually downloaded directly from the Publisher's e-mail.

Copy the WATTwin, WATTdos, and the compressed DATABASE zip file into the new TRACK folder from the Publisher's e-mail or from a disc:

From a disc (a 3½" floppy or a CD disc), copy the three-WATT zip files into the new folder. You can download the PKUNZIP.EXE file from the websites of either LPC or BRIS. Open these three files: **WATTwin.zip**; **WATTdos.zip**; and **DATA2011.zip**.

Including PKUNZIP, there are now four files in the new TRACK directory. From here, the WATTwin, WATTdos, and the DATABASE programs can be installed.

The three zip files in TRACK can be opened with WinZip or with any similar program. We prefer the simplicity of PKUNZIP.

Opening Files

At the C:\TRACK> prompt, just type PKUNZIP before the name of any file to be opened. Place a space between PKUNZIP and the complete file name. For example, the command "PKUNZIP WATTdos.zip" will open the WATTdos file.

There are several common HELP files among the programs. An "Overwrite Warning" for multiple files can be overcome by hitting "A" on your keyboard.

Once you have installed all three programs, you are ready to create two **icons** on your Windows Desktop: **WATTdos** and **WATTwin**. This is easy. But if you are unsure how to do it, see the **HowTo** file located in the TRACK folder or at the lower left corner of LPC's website, **HorseRacingUSA.com** (you can also find BRIS help at that location). Done properly, the WATTdos icon will always present a black box on your screen with the DOS prompt, C:\TRACK>.

To operate any **Winning at the Track** program, you only need to type any one of four words at the C:\TRACK\> prompt ...

PKUNZIP (to open zip files that are located in the TRACK folder);

TRANSFER (to run the DATABASE Transfer program);

DESKTOP (to operate the WATTdos program);

TUTOR (to run the tutorial).
